It also contains the Scheme of Delegations, which sets out how certain decisions are delegated to officers.

#### 6 Part 4- Rules of Procedure

This part of the Constitution sets out the rules governing the procedure of access to information, budget and policy, executive, scrutiny, financial, contract and

procurement and officer employment matters.

#### 7 Part 5- Codes and Protocols

541 - 656

This part of the Constitution sets out the codes and protocols that govern the behaviours of Councillors (also known as 'Members') and employees (also known as 'Officers'), as well as codes and protocols governing Planning, Gifts and Hospitality.

#### 8 Part 6- Members Allowances

This part of the Constitution sets out the different financial allowances for Councillors (also known as 'Members') based on roles and responsibilities.
