Portfolio Responsibilities

Where not otherwise reserved to the Council, a committee of the Council or other body under the Local Authority Functions Regulations, or where authority has not been delegated to a Chief Officer and, in consultation with a relevant Cabinet Member, as necessary, to take responsibility within the Cabinet for all matters relating to:

- Community safety and the development and implementation of the Council's Community Safety policies.
- Tackling anti-social behaviour and local crime and disorder.
- The Council's contribution to domestic violence services.
- Magistrates Courts within the Borough.
- The Regulation of Investigatory Powers.
- Town tasking and cross-organisational service delivery at a town level.
- In association with the Leader of the Council, town working and the development and co-ordination of the work of Town Lead Members.

- The improvement of the visual appearance of the Borough (the 'streetscene') to create a better place to live.
- The policy direction for countryside management, nature reserves, parks, green spaces and visitors centres.
- Highways network management and maintenance.
- Transport, vehicle and plant management, and the integration of transport services provided by Council services (including special education needs).
- Environmental services including cleansing, grounds maintenance, public conveniences and the maintenance of water courses.
- The waste strategy and waste collection and disposal services.
- Environmental health, trading standards and consumer protection.
- The application of licensing regimes for which the Council is the designated authority, including taxi licensing.

	The commissioning and procurement of services which fall within the remit of the Cabinet Member.
