## Key Decisions

## Chief Officer Recruitment and the Role of Monitoring Officer

On 12 October, 2016 the Chief Officers Terms and Conditions Sub Committee will meet and consider the following recommendations:

- (1) That the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Leader of the Council and the relevant Cabinet Member, appoint a suitably qualified and experienced interim Director - Neighbourhood Services on a six month contract;
- (2) That the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Leader of the Council and the relevant Cabinet Member, appoint a suitably qualified and experienced interim Monitoring Officer on a six month contract;
- (3) That the action taken by the Chief Executive to act-up the Senior Service Manager (DC) to Director for a period of six months from 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2016, be endorsed and that the post be designated Interim Director – Resources;
- (4) That, in order to allow for the effective conduct of the Council's business, the Leader of the Council, and the full Council respectively, be recommended:-
  - (a) to transfer the Executive and Non-Executive authority delegated to the post of Assistant Chief Executive with the Council's Scheme of Delegations to the post of Interim Director – Resources;
  - (b) to transfer the Executive and Non-Executive authority delegated to the post of Director – Governance to the posts of Interim Director – Resources and Monitoring Officer, as deemed necessary, following the appointment of a person to the role of Monitoring Officer.
