

Budget and Corporate Scrutiny Board 9 November, 2016

Summary of Matters Considered at the Board Report of Councillor Peter Hughes

Quarter 2 Council Wide Budget Monitoring

The Board received a report on the Council's budget position at the end of quarter 2 of 2016/2017.

The Board is pleased to hear that the Council is on track to deliver the £24m of savings agreed by the Council at its meeting on 8th March, 2016.

The Board discussed the three key strategic risks that the Council currently faces and in particular, the implications of the Government's instruction to establish a Children's Trust. It is noted that the size of the budget to be transferred to the Children's Trust is under negotiation; however Ofsted's inspection report did not identify any issues regarding the level of funding for the service.

The Board was informed that a report was to be submitted to the Cabinet in December asking it to consider the vision for the six towns of Sandwell. It has been acknowledged that each town is different and that separate visions for each town would be advantageous to best meet the needs of residents. The Board welcomes this approach and **recommended** to the Interim Director – Resources that a series of localised workshops, involving members, senior officers and partners should take place to map out each town's assets, services and facilities. The Board feels that the Neighbourhood Model of working has been successful, however, and does not wish to see this changed at present.
