- 3.1 At the meeting of the Council on 22 May 2018, the Council established the Select Committee for Electoral Participation. Changes in electorate numbers had been highlighted and the Committee was established to examine the current processes employed in Sandwell and to look at ways to maximise electoral registration, engagement and participation within the borough.
- 3.2 The purpose of the Committee is to work collaboratively with Members, officers, other council departments and partnership groups to discuss and investigate the current mechanisms in place to actively engage and promote electoral participation and registration.
