#### 78/19 **Minutes**

#### 79/19 Mayor's Announcements

The Mayor welcomed students from Q3 Langley school as part of National Democracy Week.

The Mayor also made reference to the display/promotion in the foyer as part of National Adoption Week and asked elected members to take every opportunity to promote adoption. [IL0: UNCLASSIFIED]

The Mayor also thanked everyone for their foodbank donations.

Details of Mayoral engagements since the last meeting of the Council had been circulated to members.

In particular, reference was made to the meetings that had taken place in the run up to Remembrance. The Festival Remembrance would take place on 9<sup>th</sup> November at West Bromwich Town Hall.

The Mayor took the opportunity to send well wishes to those members suffering ill health – Councillors Horton, P M Hughes, Lewis and Tagger.

#### 82/19 Proposals to Depart from the Local Development Plan at Powke Lane Open Space, Rowley Regis

At the meeting of the Planning Committee held on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2018, consideration was given to planning application DC/18/62046 which sought approval for the construction of a new cemetery including; site remediation, widening of existing access off Powke Lane; office building and operational yard, parking, CCTV, lighting, landscaping and other associated site improvement works on part of Powke Lane Open Space.

Planning Committee approved the planning application, subject to the application being referred to Full Council as a departure from the Local Plan.

The site was allocated as Public Open Space within the Council's adopted Site Allocations and Delivery Development Plan Document. It was necessary for the Council to consider whether or not to grant an exception to its policy to allow the application to proceed.

The matter had been considered by Council at its meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2018 (Minute No. 95/18 referred) where it had been referred to the relevant Cabinet Member and Scrutiny Board for consideration of options. The Safer Neighbourhoods and Active Communities Scrutiny Board had subsequently considered the options and had concluded that the proposal was the best option available to the Council.

Several objections were received from Members, in particular:-

- there was very little open space in the borough the Friends Group and local businesses objected to the proposal;
- there were no significant changes since the debate at full Council in October 2018;
- burial may not be a sustainable solution and further issues may arise in the future when the plot became full and the remaining green space would be targeted;
- a Freedom of Information request had indicated that there were sufficient burial spaces for the next 40+ years and it may be that burials would lessen with people using alternatives;
- an Environment Agency report indicated that the site was high risk which caused concern;
- other sites should be looked at where the impact would be lessened;
- there needed to be a good reason to build on green space, such as housing, offices for employment, etc.
- the area was densely populated and, during construction, the works would have a major impact on the area;
- boroughs like Sandwell could not afford to lose green space;
- this was considered to be a short-term solution, in the future the Council would again be looking elsewhere.

In contrast, whilst the Cabinet Member for Safer Communities appreciated and understood the concern regarding loss of greenspace and wildlife, cemeteries were becoming a sanctuary for wildlife and there would still be greenspace. Families may wish to bury their loved ones and visit them every day. An alternative for residents would be burial at another borough, paying increased costs. The greenspace would still be there and, whilst members were focused on concerns, they were forgetting the local people who wished to bury their loved ones.

In accordance with Standing Order No. 12, Councillor Preece called for a named vote. The required support to the request was achieved and the motion put to a named vote, as follows:-

**Resolved** that an exception to the Local Plan be allowed in respect of planning application DC/18/62046 to support the construction of a new cemetery in Rowley Regis to include; site remediation, widening of existing access off Powke Lane; office building and operational yard, parking, CCTV, lighting, landscaping and other associated site and access improvement works on part of Powke Lane Open Space, rear of 55-91 (odds) Powke Lane, Rowley Regis.

#### 83/19 West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority

Councillor Edwards, the member nominated pursuant to Section 41 of the Local Government Act 1985 to report on the activities of the West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority, presented an update on the work of the Fire Authority.

Particular reference was made to:-

#### Revenue Finances

Core funding provided by the Government to West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority (WMFRA) had been reduced by 50% ( $\pounds$ 38m) during continuous downward spending reviews since 2011, including cuts in the current financial year of  $\pounds$ 0.690m.

It was expected that 2020/2021 would be the first year without significant reductions since 2011. However, funding would still not allow for any growth or recovery.

#### - Capital Spending

For several years the government had failed to provide any capital funding for West Midlands Fire Service and this continued to be the case going into 2020/2021.

Earmarked authority reserves were being used to rebuild Aston fire station. Reserves were also being used to fund an essential vehicle replacement programme, including front line fire appliances. Other items of essential capital expenditure included extensive IT upgrades which were vital to the joint West Midlands/Staffordshire fire control room.

Cash reserves held by the Fire Authority to deliver its essential capital programme would be exhausted by 2021/2022.

# Future Governance of West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority

A proposal had been developed to transfer responsibilities for the governance of WMFS to the West Midlands Combined Authority.

In the last stages of drafting the Parliamentary Order the Government had failed to provide surety for the future delegation of accountabilities and responsibilities of the Chief Fire Officer including certainty in ring-fencing WMFS budget and financial reserves. This prevented the unanimous support of all seven West Midlands local authorities being achieved and the proposal was withdrawn.

WMFS would therefore continue to be governed by the West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority.

#### - Inspection by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services

Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire and Rescue Services (HMICFRS), the new government inspectorate, had carried out an independent inspection of West Midlands Fire Service. The headlines from the report were that WMFS was 'good' in all the areas inspected and 'outstanding' in its emergency response. WMFS was the only fire service inspected under the new regime to receive an 'outstanding' grading.

There were some communication and cultural issues mentioned in the report which in part arose from last year's trade dispute.

Last autumn, prior to the inspection, WMFS, in partnership with trade unions, had already agreed to put in place an independent cultural review which had now been published. The recommendations would be analysed and developed into an implementation plan.

The full inspection report was available on the HMICFRS website.

#### - Performance

Despite unprecedented cuts in government funding, West Midlands Fire Service continued to maintain its five-minute target response time to category 1 incidents which threatened life or property.

Following a burst water main incident in Wednesbury the previous day, members wished to place on record their thanks to the Fire/Police/Ambulance Services and South Staffs Water for their excellent response.

#### 84/19 Transport for West Midlands

Councillor Akhter, the member nominated pursuant to Section 41 of the Local Government Act 1985 to report on the activities of Transport for West Midlands, presented an update on the work of the Transport Authority.

Particular reference was made to:-

#### - Commonwealth Games

The transport planning for the Commonwealth Games was proceeding well with work progressing in ensuring a fully integrated transport response to the Games.

A Games Strategic Transport Plan had been developed and taken to the West Midlands Combined Authority Board in September. The plan had been published as part of a twelveweek engagement period and set out the approach to the detailed planning required for the integrated transport network.

#### - M5 Oldbury Viaduct Works

The project remained on track for completion in Autumn 2019. Some 14,000 repairs had been carried out on the northbound carriageway and good progress had been made. The contraflow had been removed and a 40mph introduced. The next major milestone for the project would be the completion of works on the deck.

#### - Bus Network

Ring and Ride Update

From 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019, the Ring and Ride service was operated by West Midlands Accessible Transport, a new company wholly owned subsidiary of National Express West Midlands. The Ring and Ride team currently operating the service transferred to the new operator, so users could be assured of the same high standard of customer care previously enjoyed. Going forward, TfWM would be working with the new operator to ensure Ring and Ride services continued to work for local people and, wherever possible, were improved based on customer feedback.

## - HS2 Connectivity

**Sprint:** Work had been progressing on the three priority Sprint Routes, Walsall to Birmingham via Sandwell (A34), Birmingham to Birmingham Airport and Solihull (A45), and Sutton Coldfield to Birmingham via Langley (SBL), with work being undertaken by TfWM and local authorities.

**Rail:** Significant activity had been underway developing a number of rail investment projects. A joint project team had been created to help the delivery of the investment programme. Projects currently underway included Dudley Port Station – outline proposals to improve interchange facilities and accessibility at the station.

#### - Metro Programme

Representatives from Metro Alliance joined the meeting to advise of the series of drop-in-sessions that had been arranged for residents and businesses, to raise awareness of the work starting and to gain feedback. The sessions were intended to be an informal, high-level overview of the scheme, building on the information already provided.

#### - Sustainable Travel

#### **Travel Choices**

Transport for West Midlands (TfWM) continued to support those working, studying and living in Sandwell to travel around the West Midlands region.

The team would continue to offer help to those affected by highway improvements on Junction 10 of the M6 when work began there in 2020 and also work with the Commonwealth Games team and engage with residents around the site of the new Aquatic Centre, where construction had already started.

- Living Streets Walk to School Programme

In partnership with TfWM, Living Streets had been working with Sandwell primary schools to encourage children to walk to school with the aim of improving wellbeing and reducing the number of cars at the school gates to reduce vehicle emissions and improve road safety.

In response to a number of questions raised by members regarding:-

- service users complained of being cold and splashed by water at the new style bus stops at Stone Cross – previously the shelters were enclosed – could they be replaced with the previous style;
- the previous style bus stops provided a level of protection for those with children, they were now open to the road and the elements. When TfWM had been contacted, they stated that the new style maximised the space available for video advertising;
- could more information be provided regarding the proposed Sprint Route on the A34;
- problems with overcrowding at train station in Tipton was causing problems for residents/parents with toddlers, TfWM had planning permission, however, funding had not been allocated;
- National Express had rescued the Ring and Ride Service, however, there was a need to look at reliability;

the lead member for transport confirmed she would refer the matters back to TfWM for comment.

#### 85/19 West Midlands Police and Crime Panel

The Council's substitute representative on the West Midlands Police and Crime Panel, Councillor R Jones, provided members with an update on the work undertaken by the West Midlands Police and Crime Panel.

The Panel had five statutory responsibilities that were the core element of its work programme:-

- scrutinise and make a recommendation on the Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC) proposed policing precept and budget, with the power to veto the precept;
- scrutinise and comment on the PCC's Police and Crime Plan;
- review the PCC's Annual Report;
- hold confirmation hearings before the PCC made certain senior appointments; and
- handle non-criminal complaints about the PCC, referring serious complaints to the Independent Office for Police Conduct.

Panels were also encouraged to undertake wider exploratory work to build knowledge and insight and hold the PCC to account.

Highlights from 2018/19:-

- the Panel challenged the PCC on response times to the 101 non-emergency number;
- Panel members raised residents' concerns about Police visibility and questioned the PCC and Deputy Chief Constable on resources for local policing and improving public engagement;
- members advocated greater promotion of the PCC's Active Citizens Fund to encourage greater take up by local groups;
- the Panel sought assurance from the PCC of his oversight to improving crime recording arrangements following the inadequate rating;

- the Panel encouraged the PCC to evaluate the cashable and non-cashable benefits of the WMP2020 force business transformation programme and consider how best to communicate these to the public;
- a subgroup of Panel members carried out detailed scrutiny of budget issues, pressures and projections ahead of the formal review of the PCC's precept proposals;
- the Panel examined the proposal to transfer the PCC and spoke to the West Midlands Mayor, the PCC and officers of the West Midlands Combined Authority before responding to the WMCA consultation.

Activities July - October 2019:-

- training and induction an induction was held in July 2019 for new members to learn about the role of the Panel. A police finance briefing took place in September and a briefing by the PCC and Force was scheduled, including a tour of the call centre. The Annual Police and Crime Panel Conference in November 2019 would provide an opportunity for members to attend a number of topical police and crime workshops;
- review of the PCC's Annual Report in September the Panel considered the draft Annual Report and questioned the PCC on progress made during the previous year towards his Police and Crime Plan priorities. A number of suggestions were made for the final version of the report.

In response to questions in relation to:-

- an update with regard to the 101 non-emergency number;
- raising the issue of knife crime at the next meeting, including figures and what was proposed;

Councillor R Jones undertook to take the issues back to the Panel.

#### 86/19 West Midlands Combined Authority

The Leader provided members with an update on the work undertaken by the West Midlands Combined Authority.

Particular reference was made to:-

- West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner – proposed transfer of functions

The Combined Authority consulted across the seven West Midlands Council areas (constituent authorities) on the proposals to transfer the powers and responsibilities of the West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner to the Mayor of the West Midlands in May 2020.

The Combined Authority Board received a report on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019 setting out the findings of the consultation. It was noted that there were strong levels of support throughout the consultation for transferring the Police and Crime Commission role with that of the Mayor, however, the Board did not agree to progress the proposal to the next stage and for the time being, the Police Crime Commission role would remain separate to that of the Mayor.

- West Midlands Fire and Rescue Authority

The proposed transition of the West Midlands Fire and Rescue Service would not be progressed due to the Final Draft Statutory Order from the Home Office, containing an amendment that led the Chief Fire Officer to advise that the Order should not be consented to as the change was too significant and compromised the intent of the proposed governance changes.

In order for the transfer of the governance of West Midlands Fire and Rescue Service to the Combined Authority to go ahead, it required a unanimous agreement amongst the Constituent Councils and the Combined Authority as each Authority must give their consent to the Home Office for the Order to be laid before Parliament.

The implication of the Order not receiving unanimous consent from the seven Constituent Councils had been the Home Office taking the decision to withdraw the Order from being laid before Parliament, and the proposed transfer of governance of West Midlands Fire and Rescue Service to the Combined Authority could not proceed as envisaged.

As a result, the Combined Authority had taken the decision to stand down the project team working on the transfer. The governance arrangements for West Midlands Fire and Rescue Service would remain as they currently were, overseen by a Fire and Rescue Authority made up of local elected councillors.

- Projects benefiting from Combined Authority funding in Sandwell

During the last year, an increased number of opportunities had been secured for Sandwell from the Combined Authority. Details on these projects were set out below:-

#### Delivery of a comprehensive residential redevelopment of Bescot/Friar Park, Wednesbury

The Council and WMCA had entered an agreement to work together collaboratively to deliver a masterplan and disposal strategy for the Bescot/Friar Park site for comprehensive residential redevelopment.

The agreement was dependent on the acquisition and remediation of the former sewage works by WMCA and the assembly of a comprehensive redevelopment site. The Council and WMCA would then work together to prepare a master plan for the site, jointly secure Outline Planning Permission and agree a detailed delivery and marketing strategy for the site.

The site was considered to have an approximate development capacity of over 750 dwellings which would make a significant contribution to the Council's housing delivery targets.

#### WMCA Housing First Pilot

On 10 May 2018, it was announced that WMCA would receive £9.6m to deliver a Housing First Pilot. The pilot would operate up to the close of March 2023. The Council had been allocated £935,137 of the funding with a view to facilitating up to 55 tenancies during the course of the pilot.

Following initial assessment, scoping exercises and a procurement process Accord Housing Association Ltd was awarded to deliver the pilot.

#### Wednesbury to Brierley Hill metro extension

The Wednesbury to Brierley Hill extension to the West Midlands Metro network would provide a direct rapid transit link to Birmingham, West Bromwich, Wolverhampton, Dudley and Merry Hill/Brierley Hill benefitting residents and workers in the Golds Hill, Great Bridge, Horseley Heath and Dudley Port areas of Sandwell. There would be seventeen stops including six in Sandwell at Golds Hill (provisional), Great Bridge, Horseley Road, Dudley Port (for interchange with rail), Sedgley Road East and Birmingham New Road.

Overall, the scheme would cost £449m, this was made up of £207m of Transforming Cities Fund which was devolved to the WMCA, £103m of CA Investment Fund with the balance being made up of Prudential Borrowing against future fare box revenue. Work would start towards the end of 2019 with completion in 2023.

#### A4123 Birchley Island/M5 Junction 2 Improvement

A major highway improvement was planned at Birchley Island to improve capacity, reduce delays, provide pedestrian and cycle facilities and improved bus journey time reliability.

The scheme would cost £26.2m. Funding was made up of £16.15m Local Growth Fund, £2.62m of SMBC funding and £7.48 of WMCA Transforming Cities Fund.

Subject to the outcome of any public inquiry, work should start in late 2021 and take approximately two years to complete.

#### Bull Street, West Bromwich

The WMCA Town Centre Programme was intended to provide funding, expertise and support from the WMCA and other partners to revitalise five selected pilot areas, one of which was West Bromwich Town Centre. A collective share of £20m between these areas would also assist local authorities to deliver tangible, capital regeneration interventions.

Sandwell proposed to use this assistance to deliver major regeneration initiatives to the eastern most part of the High Street, an area suffering from acute retail decline and in need of swift reinvention. The demolition of the Multi Storey Car Park on Bull Street was the first major site which Sandwell was seeking funding support from the WMCA. A business case and funding agreement was being prepared for consideration by Cabinet.

In addition to the major capital interventions, the Town Centre Programme would look to implement a number of 'softer' improvements to West Bromwich. As such, a c.£220k initial proposal has been submitted to the WMCA for public realm works to the top of Princess Parade, a key gateway site to the town. These would aim to transform the area from an uninspiring entrance to a vibrant, attractive and aspirational town centre arrival site and would also look to address a severe lack of urban greenery in the area.

#### Adult Education Budget

WMCA had taken control of the £126m regional Adult Education Budget with delivery agreements in place for the 2019/20 academic year. Sandwell Adult and Family Learning Service had two Adult Education budgets 2019-2020 under the WMCA.

#### 87/19 Extension to Six Month Attendance Rule

An extension of the six-month attendance rule was sought to excuse the non-attendance of Councillor P M Hughes at Council meetings for a period of six months.

Due to Councillor P M Hughes suffering ill-health, a formal request had been received for an extension to the six-month rule to be approved. Council could only consider such a request where approval was given in relation to the reasons for non-attendance before the end of the relevant six-month period, which would be on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

Under the circumstances, it was requested that Council approved an extension of the six-month rule for Councillor P M Hughes and that Council's best wishes be conveyed to Councillor P M Hughes for a speedy recovery. The extension of time would be effective for a six-month period from 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019, expiring on the Annual Meeting of Council on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020. This did not, of course, prevent Councillor P M Hughes from returning to meetings at any time if her health improved sufficiently.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously:

**Resolved** that, having regard to the circumstances of the absence of Councillor P M Hughes from Council meetings, approval be given to the waiving of the requirements of Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972 and an extension of the six month rule for Councillor P M Hughes for a period of six months, with effect from 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019, expiring the Annual Meeting of Council on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

#### 88/19 Appointments to Positions, Committees/Boards and Other Bodies

#### **Statutory Data Protection Officer**

The General Data Protection Regulations required each Public Authority to appoint a named officer to the post of Statutory Data Protection Officer (DPO).

The DPO would be the Council's main point of contact for any data protection issues and provided both the interpretation of legislation as well as the practical implementation on operational issues. The DPO would also be the single point of contact with the Information Commissioner's Office.

Following the retirement of the previously named officer, the Service Manager - Legal and Assurance and Deputy Monitoring Officer (Maria Price) would take over the role.

#### Health and Wellbeing Board

At its meeting on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019, the Health and Wellbeing Board gave consideration to representation on the Board by the Chief Executive of the Sandwell Children's Trust, as a discretionary member with no voting rights. In addition, there were some minor changes to the membership in line with the new CCG structure. Approval was sought to the revised membership of the Health and Wellbeing Board for Sandwell, to include representation from Sandwell Children's Trust and amendments to the CCG representation (as set out in Appendix A).

#### Sandwell Children's Trust Board – Non-Executive Directors

When establishing the arrangements for the delivery of Sandwell's children's social care services through Sandwell Children's Trust, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was entered into with the Council. The MoU included the arrangements for appointing the non-executive directors of the Trust board.

The MoU provided that the Council could appoint two nonexecutive directors to the Trust Board. The Council could remove, or propose changes to, any person as Council appointed nonexecutive director from the Trust Board so long as, prior to any resolution to remove or propose to change that person, it had considered any comments from the Trust Board about the proposal, and that the Secretary of State be invited to "make written representations to the Council within 10 working days of being notified of the matter.... In making its decision the Council must take into account the representations made by the Secretary of State."

At the Council's Cabinet meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2017, it was agreed that the Council would nominate only elected members or officers for the non-executive director roles on the board. It was further agreed that there would be one elected member, nominated by the Council, and one officer, nominated by the Chief Executive.

The Council recognised that in both the member and officer nominations, it was important to take account of any potential conflicts of interest that these appointments may have in order not to hinder the effective operation of the board or the Council itself; the non-executive directors had a fiduciary duty to the Trust board.

Since the inception of the Trust board, the Council's two appointed non-executive directors had been Councillor Sandars and Stuart Lackenby. Following Stuart's recent appointment to a new role in the Council as Director of Adult Social Care; this created a conflict of interest requiring him to resign from the Board. This need for change had led to the consideration of the councillor appointment also.

It was now proposed to nominate two new non-executive directors to Sandwell Children's Trust Board, Councillor Allen, who would bring experience of understanding data and monitoring performance, and the new incumbent to the role as Director of Prevention and Protection, Neil Cox.

The Trust Board had been consulted on the Council's intentions and a letter had now been sent to the Secretary of State.

It was proposed that the responses of the Secretary of State and Trust Board would be submitted to Cabinet, at its meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019, where a final decision would be made.

#### **Resolved:-**

 appoint the Service Manager – Legal and Assurance, Maria Price, as the Council's Statutory Data Protection Officer (DPO) with immediate effect;

- (2) approve the revised establishment of the Sandwell Health and Wellbeing Board, as set out in Appendix A, with immediate effect, in accordance with Section 194 of the Health and Social Care Act, 2012;
- (3) approve the proposal to nominate two new nonexecutive directors to Sandwell Children's Trust Board, Councillor Peter Allen and the Director of Prevention and Protection, Neil Cox, with final approval being made by Cabinet at its meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

#### 89/19 Minutes of the Chief Officers Terms and Conditions Committee
