Nominations for the Offices of Mayor and Deputy Mayor of Sandwell for the 2013/14 Municipal Year

1. Summary Statement

- 1.1 The Committee is invited to consider the nomination of persons to the offices of the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor of Sandwell for the Municipal Year 2013/2014.
- 1.2 The Council at its meeting on 10 January 2013 resolved that the process for the selection of Mayor for the municipal year 2013/14 and subsequent years be based on the following criteria:
 - Nominees shall be serving members of Sandwell Council who have not previously served as Mayor
 - Nominees shall have given notable service to the Borough of Sandwell as a councillor and/or within the local community
 - Each nomination shall be submitted by a serving member of the Council supported by five other serving members of the Council, regardless of political party.
- 1.3 All members of the Council have been advised of the process and invited to submit nominations for the office of Mayor.
- 1.4 There is one nomination in respect of Councillor Linda Horton. The nomination is supported by the requisite five serving members of the Council.
- 1.5 The nomination for the office of Deputy Mayor will be reported at the meeting.
