#### **DECISION RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### That the committee:

- 1. Considers and agrees the proposed changes to polling districts and polling places as set out in Appendix 1 to this report to take effect at all elections from 1 December 2019.
- 2. Considers and agrees the proposed changes to polling places as set out in Appendix 2 to take effect at all elections immediately.

#### 1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 The report sets out proposed changes as a result of the statutory polling district and polling places review.

#### 2 IMPLICATIONS FOR VISION 2030

- 2.1 Ambition 10 Sandwell now has a national reputation for getting things done, where all local partners are focused on what really matters in people's lives and communities.
- 2.2 The proposals of the review of polling districts, places and stations helps ensure that the electorate can effectively engage in democracy arrangements and influence the future direction of the Council.

#### 3 BACKGROUND AND MAIN CONSIDERATIONS

- 3.1 Section 18B of the Representation of the People Act (RPA) 1983 states the authority must designate the polling places for the polling districts in its area. Each polling district must have a polling place and it is the duty of the council to designate polling places and keep them under review. The council is required, so far as is reasonable and practicable, to designate polling places which are accessible to disabled electors.
- 3.2 Paragraph 25 of Schedule 1 to the RPA 1983 states that the Returning Officer must provide a sufficient number of polling stations, shall allocate electors to those polling stations, and those polling stations shall be in the polling place for that district.
- 3.3 Consultation took place from Friday 28 June 2019 to Friday 30 August 2019 with consultees including all Elected Members, MPs, local Political Parties and local disability charities.
- 3.4 A summary of the responses from the consultations outlining the proposed changes to polling districts and polling stations is included in Appendix 3.

#### 4 THE CURRENT POSITION

- 4.1 Appendix 1 details the proposed changes to polling districts and polling stations following the statutory review.
- 4.2 Section 18C (1) of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (RPA 1983) states that local authorities must carry out and complete a review of polling districts and polling places in the period specified by section 18C(2)(a) of the RPA 1983.
- 4.3 All local authorities must review their UK Parliamentary polling districts and polling places at least once every five years.
- 4.4 The next compulsory review must be started and completed between 1 October 2018 and 31 January 2020 (inclusive).

#### 5 CONSULTATION (CUSTOMERS AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS)

5.1 The Acting Returning Officers, all Elected Members, MPs, local Political Parties and local disability charities have been consulted in relation to the alternative polling stations and polling places detailed in Appendix 1.

#### 6 ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS

6.1 Alternative options to the existing provision of polling stations are detailed in Appendix 1

#### 7 STRATEGIC RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

7.1 The financial implications have been set out in Appendix 1 of this report.

#### 8 LEGAL AND GOVERNANCE CONSIDERATIONS

- 8.1 Section 18B of the RPA Act 1983 states the authority must designate the polling places for the polling districts in its area. Paragraph 25 of Schedule 1 to the RPA 1983 states that the Returning Officer must provide a sufficient number of polling stations, shall allocate electors to those polling stations, and those polling stations shall be in the polling place for that district.
- 8.2 A building should not be designated that does not have access for the disabled if another suitable building is available in the polling district. However, a building would not be a more suitable polling place if it were so far removed from most of the electors in the polling district.
- 8.3 Section 18C (1) (RPA 1983) states that local authorities must carry out and complete a review of polling districts and polling places in the period specified by section 18C(2)(a) of the RPA 1983. Paragraph 25(1) of Schedule 1 to the RPA 1983 states that the Returning Officer must provide sufficient numbers of polling stations and allot electors to those polling stations. The next compulsory review must be started and complete between 1 October 2018 and 31 January 2020 (inclusive). The review will undertake all the legislative steps set out in Schedule A1 to the RPA 1983.

#### 9 **EQUALITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

9.1 The Review included use of the Electoral Commissions Evaluation Checklist which addresses equality and diversity issues relevant to polling districts, places and stations as seen in Appendix 3. Accessibility for members of minority or disadvantaged groups is a key issue in the selection of suitable polling Stations.

#### 10 DATA PROTECTION IMPACT ASSESSMENT

10.1 The proposals are in line with data protection regulations.

11.1 The Council is under a statutory duty to ensure a polling place exists in each of its polling districts unless special circumstances apply.

# 1. The purpose of the proposal or decision required (Please provide as much information as possible)

The Electoral Administration Act 2006 requires the Local Authority to review all polling districts and polling places every 5 years. The last review was carried out in 2014. The review looks at the boundaries of polling districts and the location of polling stations. The review is to ensure all electors are given the same opportunity to cast their vote.

Any changes to the current setup is not intended or likely to have any significant impact on any particular group. The main area for any potential negative impact is assessed as being on the grounds of disability, but there are alternative ways of voting which can mitigate against this.

### 2. Evidence used/considered

We have used evidence about accessibility of existing and any proposed polling stations in making this assessment. This has come from:

- Polling Station Inspector surveys carried out annually on existing stations
- Feedback from Presiding Officers and polling station staff
- Contact with and inspection of polling stations

We have also taken into consideration feedback from consultation.

### 3. Consultation

The notice of review was published on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019 on the Council's website and at the Council House Oldbury.

All Acting Returning Officers, Elected Members, MPs, local Political Parties and local disability charities received notification of the review. Submissions were invited by 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

We have received feedback from members of the public but none from the disability groups. The main feedback and submissions have been from Elected Members mainly regarding looking at alternative polling stations. The concerns expressed have been around minimising change to polling stations as many residents have become familiar with their polling stations.



### 4. Assess likely impact

Having considered the evidence and made an assessment of the likely potential impact, it is felt that there will be no change or any adverse impact on any group from the protected characteristics, as a result of the proposals arising from the review.

The only potential impact we are currently aware of would be on disabled people. This is due to polling stations which are currently situated at temporary huts. These have been used for a number of years, because currently there are not alternative premises available but this situation is kept under review.
