1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 The Director of Public Health, the Service Manager Prevention and Integration, and the CCG Partnerships Development Manager will attend the meeting to provide a presentation relating to 'Tackling Loneliness and Isolation Social Prescribing'.
- 1.2 The PowerPoint presentation will demonstrate how partners are working together across the health, social care and voluntary sectors in Sandwell.
- 1.3 Officers will outline how by working together partners can provide a coordinated accessible information system, lifestyle support options and a range of engagement opportunities and services for the people of Sandwell to enable them to live independently in the community.

- 1.4 The presentation will cover three main themes:
 - 1. Sandwell Community Connections Programme the Council offer, funded through the Better Care Fund, to co-ordinate social prescribing activity across the Borough and across all sectors.
 - 2. Social Prescribing the NHS offer through funding to Primary Care Networks.
 - 3. Community led model of care engagement with local communities and professionals in Sandwell to define and develop a new offer working with the Voluntary and Community Sector to support local people to stay well and be socially connected.
