Application for a Minor Variation of a premises licence/club premises certificate.	All cases
Application for transfer of premises licence.	If no Police objection
Application for interim authorities.	If no Police objection
Decision on whether a complaint is irrelevant, frivolous or vexatious etc.	By officer in consultation with Chair [having sought prior legal advice].
Determination of application to vary premises licence at community premises to include alternative licence condition	All cases
Decision whether to consult other responsible authorities on minor variation application	All cases
Determination of minor variation application	All cases
Decision whether to make a representation or application to review as a responsible authority	All cases
