VAT) following the conclusion of the current procurement exercise.</p>	<p>Approval is sought to procure and award a contract for the Design, Supply, Installation, Supervised Switch-on, Removal, Storage, Maintenance, Refurbishment and Repair of Festive Lighting in line with the new Procurement and Contract Procedure Rules 2022.</p>	<p>Sandwell do not have the required capability or capacity to undertake this work in house. The only alternative would be not to commit to festive lighting in the Borough with the justification being a combination of the increased costs of lighting; the impact on climate change and other pollution objectives.
