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I refer to the attached Temporary Event Notice.

At present, West Midlands Police object to the TEN. The current Premises Licence requires notice to be given of events within 14 days. Full details of the event are needed included a risk assessment in accordance with the condition below.

Events – Local policing team and licensing officer will be informed of any events or guest DJ's and be given 14 days' notice. Details should include, the nature of the event, name, address of booking party and the number of persons attending. A full risk assessment for each event must be carried out and this will include the consideration to use SIA approved door staff.

To date the only info received is very basic and limited and states it is a Round Robin event. The application states it is for a community social event but is aware that Round Robin events are actually promoted DJ events. West Midlands Police has requested additional information and a risk assessment but nothing has been received yet.

To date with basic info and no risk assessment, West Midlands Police are unable to fully consider or assesses the event without compliance with the above condition and so WMP cannot be satisfied that the licensing objectives will be upheld.



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
