The Members' Allowances Scheme was made by the Council on 2nd November 2004 and includes a Schedule of Allowances approved by the Council for 2004/5 and thereafter subject to annual adjustment. The Scheme was amended on 24th July 2007 to include payment of a Special Responsibility Allowance to Cabinet Advisors. The Council has had regard to the Report of the Black Country Independent Panel on Members' Remuneration dated 2003.

The basic allowance paid to each Councillor reflects the various roles and duties that they undertake and incorporates payment for all travel and subsistence for official business within the West Midlands Conurbation. A total of £966.91 relating to travel expenses and £311.60 for subsistence was reimbursed in respect of costs incurred for duties undertaken outside of the Conurbation.

All Councillors primary role is to represent the ward and the individual citizens who live within it. They do this by holding surgeries and undertaking casework, representing the community within the council and to other agencies, supporting local partnerships and organisations, campaigning on local issues and endeavouring to obtain resources for the ward.

In addition to the basic allowance, special responsibility allowances are paid to Members who carry out additional duties ranging from Leadership, Policy, Regulatory functions, Scrutiny, and Civic duties.

A dependant Carers' Allowance is payable to those elected Members who incur expenditure for the care of their children or other dependants whilst undertaking approved duties and they are reimbursed for costs incurred.

All Councillors are required to register with the Information Commissioner for data protection purposes the individual fee of £35 per annum is refunded to Councillors upon proof of registration.

All Councillors can choose to join the Local Government Pension Scheme and contributions are made by the Council on behalf of those members who have joined which amounts to the sum of £44,007.71
