The Members' Allowances Scheme was made by the Council on 22 May 2012 and includes a Schedule of Allowances approved by the Council for 2013/14 and thereafter subject to annual adjustment. Copies of the Scheme are available for inspection at Sandwell Council House, Freeth Street, Oldbury, West Midlands. B69 3DE

The basic allowance paid to each Councillor reflects the various roles and duties that they undertake and incorporates payment for all travel and subsistence for official business within the West Midlands Conurbation.

All Councillors primary role is to represent the ward and the individual citizens who live within it. They do this by holding surgeries and undertaking casework, representing the community within the council and to other agencies, supporting local partnerships and organisations, campaigning on local issues and endeavouring to obtain resources for the ward.

Special responsibility allowances are paid to Members who carry out additional duties ranging from Leadership, Policy, Regulatory functions, Scrutiny, and Civic duties.

A dependant Carers' Allowance is payable to those elected Members who incur expenditure for the care of their children or other dependants whilst undertaking approved duties and they are reimbursed for costs incurred.

In addition to the amounts shown 72 Councillors were reimbursed with a collective total of £164.00 relating to travel expenses for official duties undertaken outside the conurbation no subsistence was claimed.

All Councillors were entitled to join the Local Government Pension Scheme and contributions were made by the Council on behalf of those members who had joined which amounted to the sum of £67,968.67.
