## Notice of an Executive decision under the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

The Cabinet will consider and determine the following matter, which is a key decision, at their meeting on the 18th November 2021.

## **Consultation Feedback and the Future of Walker Grange**

The item seeks for the outcome of the consultation be noted, and that approval is given to Option 3 as the preferred option, to look at upgrading Walker Grange building to ensure it is fit for purpose to provide Extra Care Housing and to meet the changing need of older people including those with Dementia. Furthermore, subject to Option 3 being approved, that a further report be prepared and presented to Cabinet setting out a detailed implementation plan and the allocation of requisite financial resources.

The Regulations require that 28 clear days' notice is given before a key decision is made. However, this was not possible due to Furthermore, stakeholders involved asked for a decision to be taken as soon as possible so that the uncertainty that is being experienced at the moment can be remedied. It's on this basis that the report come to Cabinet on the 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

Due to this, and in accordance with the Regulations, the Chair of the Health and Adult Social Care Scrutiny Board has been informed of the special urgency provisions and has given their consent to the decision being taken by the Cabinet. As special urgency provisions have been agreed, this decision will not be subject to call-in.
