## Notice of an Executive decision under the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

The Cabinet will be asked to consider and determine the following matter, which is a key decision, at their meeting on 15 December 2021:

## **Oracle Fusion Implementation Partner Contract Cancellation**

The item seeks approval to authorise the Director of Finance, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources, to serve notice of termination for the contract currently delivered by Inoapps Limited regarding Contract SCC498 Appointment of Oracle SaaS Cloud System Implementation Partner, and to procure a new implementation partner for the Oracle Fusion migration project using the G-Cloud procurement framework.

The Regulations require that 28 clear days' notice is given before a key decision is made. However, this was impracticable as the contract to migrate to an Oracle Cloud system has not been delivered on time and there was now an urgent need for the council to complete the migration to a modern cloud-based Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) solution to enable the council to deliver key functions such as Finance, Human Resources, Payroll, and Procurement to effectively and efficiently support frontline services to deliver corporate objectives.

Due to this, and in accordance with the Regulations, the Chair of the Budget and Corporate Management Scrutiny Board has been informed of the special urgency provisions and has given their consent to the decision being taken by the Cabinet. As special urgency provisions have been agreed, this decision will not be subject to call-in.
