2.1 Contract has been carried out in accordance with the requirements set out in the detail of the agreement; monitoring of the service provided has been undertaken and has confirmed the quality of the service; there is no suitable alternative to provide this service in the short term.

#### 4 Context and Key Issues

- 4.1 The original contract was drawn up and agreed in 2019 with SIPS Education Ltd for the sum of £300,000 for three (3) years with the option to extend the contract to four (4) years for an additional £100,000 (1 June 2019 to 31 May 2022/23).
- 4.2 There are statutory implications for the council if these support packages are not in place both for governance and for the support of ECTs (NQTs). It is therefore recommended that the extension of this contract award is approved to ensure that our schools receive the necessary support needed to ensure that our children are to have the best possible start in life and a high-quality education throughout their school careers.
- 4.3. The current service provider, Sandwell SIPS Ltd has provided a good quality service over the past three years and approval of the extension of contract would ensure continuity to the service that is delivered to schools

### 5 Alternative Options

5.1 There are no alternative options as there is insufficient capacity within the Local Authority to carry out this work.

Resources:	There is insufficient capacity within the Council to deliver these packages of support to ECTs (NQTs) and Governors.
	The tendered cost of the contract was set at £100,000 per annum for three (3) years with an option to extend this contract for a further one (1) year period (1 June 2019 to 31 May 2022/23).
	The successful tenderer has demonstrated that they are able to deliver this service within the constraints of the current budget.
Legal and Governance:	An EU compliant procurement process was previously conducted in accordance with Public Contracts Regulations 2015.
	Legal Services were consulted prior to issue of tender documentation.
Risk:	The corporate risk management strategy has been complied with to identify and assess the risks associated with the decisions being sought. This has concluded that there are no significant risks to report. Suitable measures are in place to ensure the contract is effectively monitored to ensure it delivers the required services.
Equality:	Clauses contained within the tender documentation requiring compliance with all Acts and Codes of Practice applicable for equality and diversity have been included.
Health and Wellbeing:	Council Ambition 4 aspires to provide children with the best start in life with high quality education throughout the school career. In order to achieve this ambition they require outstanding support from their teachers.
