Health Scrutiny ensures that health matters affecting the population of Sandwell, including the delivery of healthcare by public bodies, are scrutinised by elected members.

4 Context and Key Issues

The Programme is designed to provide early diagnosis of cancer, particularly among smokers and thereby contribute towards meeting the government set ambitions that by 2028:

- An extra 55,000 people each year will survive for five years or more following their cancer diagnosis;
- Three in four cancers (75%) will be diagnosed at an early stage.

The Committee can offer suggestions on how to rollout this programme in Sandwell, ensuring that the benefit to residents is maximised.
